ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve fees as proposed for M-NCPPC Montgomery Parks Programs

BACKGROUND:

In accordance with the Department's Policy on User Fees, the Enterprise Division, which manages ice rinks, tennis centers, event centers, and seasonal park amenity facilities, presents user fee recommendations to the Planning Board on an annual or as needed basis. Prior to developing the proposed user fee schedules for facilities or programs, staff conducts surveys of other local jurisdictions' user fees for similar facilities. This information, together with input from department staff, attendance information and use patterns for each facility, and the financial picture of individual facilities including cost recovery data, is used to draft the recommended schedule of fees. Department staff presents these fee recommendations to the County Wide Recreation Advisory Board and other stakeholder groups, as appropriate, for review and discussion prior to this presentation.

Regular and timely fee adjustments are necessary to keep our fees competitive with comparable public and private self-supporting facilities or programs and/or to respond to market influences that affect pricing, user demand, etc.

The Enterprise Division's facilities are mandated by the County Council to be completely self-supporting, including facility operating costs, capital improvements and debt service for new facilities. The Parks Department's mission is to provide affordable and safe recreational programs and amenities for all. While our proposed fees reflect that mission, the County Council mandate has a significant impact on our ability to keep our fees affordable for all county residents. The department provides a 50% fee reduction for general admission fees, group lessons and programs for low income residents. In addition, the Enterprise Division uses advertised "Specials" or discounts to increase participation, thus increasing revenues. Staff continually monitors and assesses facility usage in an effort to increase participation.

Consistent with the Department's user fee policy, user fees for self-supporting Enterprise facilities, services, and programs are established at a level which (1) is competitive with comparable public and private facilities and services in the area; (2) can reasonably be expected to generate sufficient revenue to sustain administrative, operating and maintenance costs; (3) may generate surplus operating income to fund capital improvements at existing and developing facilities; and (4) reflects user demand and patterns of use. In addition, staff has completed cost recovery analysis and is cognizant of the recovery targets.

For FY 15, the Enterprise Division's budget reflects increases in costs in 3 different areas:

First is hiring two new full-time career staff to address complex Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. These two positions will begin the process of implementing the Department of Justice (DOJ) Settlement Agreement requirement to assess all "programs" for compliance and to develop and monitor a transition plan for access to recreational facilities and programs. These positions will develop and implement the Department's Inclusion Services program for program access to classes, camps and special events. They will develop and train staff on a self-evaluation tool, assess results, and complete a report on findings and remediation steps to DOJ.

The second area that will generate increased costs is the implementation of the consolidated data base to meet the County Council's mandate to provide a more streamlined and user friendly registration system through a single database among Montgomery Parks, Department of Recreation, and CUPF. The majority of the implementation costs will be in the FY 15 budget. The new system with Active Net will increase costs by approximately \$100,000 per year as the fee will be based on transactions instead of today's costs, which include only a maintenance contract and credit card fees.

Thirdly, legislative proposals to increase the minimum wage could result in salary costs for intermittent employees at an increase of up to 39% by 2016. The Maryland General Assembly House of Delegates just passed legislation to raise the minimum wage in July 2014, and again in July 2015 and July 2016. Montgomery County has voted to raise the minimum wage and the Federal government is also considering the issue. The Enterprise Division relies on seasonal/intermittent employees to operate both seasonal as well as year-round facilities. They are the people who staff the front counters, camp staff, rink guards, and serve as the manager on duty when a career employee is not present. Presently, the Enterprise seasonal staff budget is an expenditure of over \$1 million. The proposed wage of \$10.10 would increase salary costs by approximately \$400,000 in FY16.

The fee increase requests will not absorb the entire costs of the known increases but there will be a modest offset. The Division can budget for this increase as the burden of the debt service carried in past years within the operating budget no longer exists.

The FY 15 increases include the event centers, leased ice and the trains. This additional revenue will be used to cover the FY 16 costs as well. In addition, there will be continued monitoring and reviewing of revenues and expenditures to maintain a net profit in the division.

Because of the known increased costs to the division, as well as the conclusions drawn from our review of current fees, the request to increase fees is as follows:

Enterprise Division

Ice Rink, Course fees - currently \$16.00/thirty minutes raised to \$17.00/thirty minutes.

Implementation of new fees will be phased in, \$.50 in FY15 and \$.50 in FY16.

This is a 3% increase over the current ice rink course fee. The fees on classes have not been increased since 2008. Course fees for Pauline Betz Addie/Cabin John Tennis, Wheaton Indoor Tennis, and South Germantown Driving Range will be increased; the course fees currently being charged are less than current approved fees.

Little Bennett Camp Ground - Hike-in Only Camp site camp fee - currently \$25.00 raised to \$30.00.

The Campsite will have one fee for groups up to 30 people. See attached chart for more details.

MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION DEPARTMENT OF PARKS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY POLICY ON USER FEES

PURPOSE

To provide direction and consistent rationale in the development and application of User Fees charged for facilities, services and programs in the Department of Parks, Montgomery County. These fees may be applicable to facilities, services and programs such as recreation buildings, permits, ballfields, Brookside Gardens, group picnic areas, parking, Nature Centers, and primitive camping areas, which are primarily funded through general tax dollars. These fees are applicable to golf courses, ice rinks, indoor tennis courts, conference centers, miniature trains, boat rentals and rides, Wheaton Carousel, Little Bennett campground and selected activities at Brookside Gardens, which are self-supporting facilities, services and programs, and must produce sufficient revenue to cover both direct and indirect costs.

POLICY STATEMENT

Basic facilities, services and programs (such as trails, playgrounds and picnic areas), which appeal to a broad spectrum of the community, are supported by general tax dollars and are provided at no additional charge to residents. User Fees are charged for those facilities, services and programs, which provide an individual benefit or an exclusive use. User Fees may also be charged to balance use with capacity and demand, and to allocate scarce resources. When feasible, the User Fee charged should cover the direct and indirect costs of that part of the facility use, service or program from which the user derives the individual benefit. Fee reductions are given to qualified lower income individuals and groups, and may be given to qualified community based groups and qualified chartered youth groups. In general, User Fees should be higher for residents outside of Montgomery and Prince George's Counties.

User Fees for self-supporting facilities, services and programs are established at a level which (1) is competitive with comparable public and private facilities and services in the area; (2) can reasonably be expected to generate sufficient revenue to sustain administrative, administrative, operating, and maintenance costs; (3) is likely to generate surplus operating income to fund capital improvements at existing and developing facilities; and (4) reflects user demand and patterns of use.

Criteria For Determining Whether A User Fee Should Be Charged

The following criteria are considered before a User Fee is charged:

- The service can be provided only to the paying users, thus preventing access to all
 others.
- The amount of net revenue generated from the User Fee outweighs the difficulty and cost of collection.
- The application of a User Fee does not have a significant impact on usage.

Fee Reductions For Lower Income Individuals and Groups

Qualified lower income individuals and groups are offered reductions on normal fees to provide access to selected facilities, services and programs. Pursuant to County Council policy, costs not covered by lower income users will be absorbed by the general taxpayers, not by other users.

Fee reductions may be applicable to facilities, services and programs such as:

Recreation Centers Picnic Shelters Indoor Tennis Center
Gymnasiums Miniature Trains Brookside Gardens Programs and Facility
Group Picnic Areas Bus Parking Agricultural History Activity Room

Ice Rinks Boat Operations Nature Center Programs

Primitive Camping Wheaton Carousel

Fee reductions are not applicable to merchandise sales, private lessons, bus trips, concessionaire operated facilities, use of ballfields by leagues and teams, some equipment and facility rentals or seasonal reservations. Reductions may not be applicable during peak attendance hours.

Fee Reductions for Community Based Groups and Chartered Youth Groups

Qualified community based groups and qualified chartered youth groups may be offered reductions from normal fees for use of recreation centers and conference centers on weekdays. There may also be a charge to cover the operational costs of administration, security, and custodial services.

Process for Determining Fees and Fee Reductions

Annually, staff from the Department of Parks will review each fee for policy compliance, and cost basis, to determine a fee recommendation. The Park Commission will review the staff fee recommendations and act on them. Approved User Fees will be reflected in the Department of Parks User Fees schedule.

The Department of Parks, in cooperation with the County's social service agencies, and the Department of Recreation, will establish eligibility guidelines, application procedures, and fee reduction levels for lower income individuals and groups, community based groups, and chartered youth groups.

Any reduction of fee not specifically mentioned in this policy must have the approval of the Director of Parks. The Director of Parks' determination will provide the final decision in this fee reduction process.

Special Event organizers are encouraged to submit their requests at least 60 days prior to the event date for any type or size of event and 120 days in advance if the event is likely to attract more than 500 people. Certain Guidelines must be followed as all of our parks are public property. Additional pricing for policing, trash removal, facility or amenity used, sanitation services, crowd control, insurance and related traffic or parking issues must be considered and addressed before a permit can be issued. Fees vary and are evaluated on a case by case basis.
