The Montgomery County Department of Parks is in the process of securing permits for the installation of a SEED Self-Sufficient Classroom Building at a proposed learning center facility within Black Hill Regional Park in Boyds, Maryland. During the process of preparing the site plan it was determined that prescriptive compliance with Executive Regulation 08-16, Sections 18.2.3.2.3.3 and 18.2.3.2.3.5 could not be achieved. Through the use of performance based design, the accompanying drawing demonstrates the SEED Classroom Building is within the 200-foot standard pre-connect hose distance to the furthest point in the structure as provided upon the County Fire apparatus. The smoke detector and security alarm will be linked to the park police. The structure is 801 square feet. Access will not be allowed to the structure without a responsible instructor or park employee present.
