






**FPP and RSP Briefing: County growth trends and expectations related to the 2020 Subdivision Staging Policy update**

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Staff from the Functional Planning and Policy and the Research and Special Projects divisions continue to prepare an update to the Subdivision Staging Policy. Policy update recommendations will be partly informed by demographic trends and expectations for future county growth. Today's presentation will provide an overview of trends among populations and households, in addition to reviewing the results of the most recently completed long-range population and household forecast, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments Round 9.1 Cooperative Forecast.

The review of the Round 9.1 Cooperative Forecast results will highlight the following topics:

- County growth expectations for the period 2015-2045

- Forecast process, assumptions, and methodology

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
