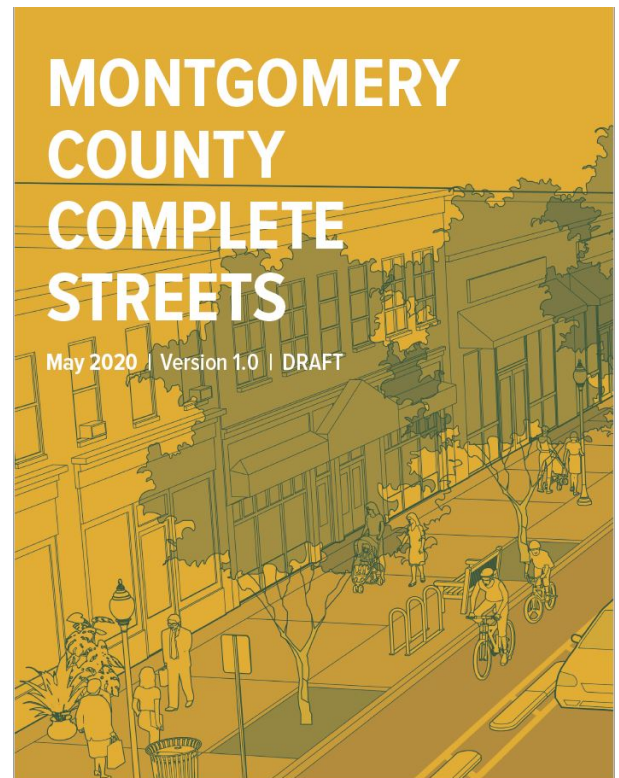
Description

The Montgomery County Planning Department and the Montgomery County Department of Transportation have jointly developed a complete streets design guideline for use in the design of county roadways. The draft document has been posted on the Planning Department's website titled "Montgomery County Complete Streets, Version 1.0, May 2020." It can be accessed and downloaded at <https://montgomeryplanning.org/planning/transportation/complete-streets/>.¹ Planning and MCDOT staff will provide a briefing on this project at the Planning Board meeting.

Schedule

The following schedule is planned for the public and Planning Board review of this document:

- Document posting on Montgomery Planning website – May 25
- Planning Board briefing – June 11
- Briefing with the Pedestrian Master Plan Community Advisory Group – June 11
- Online public information meeting – June 17
- Committee/advocacy organization meetings – ongoing
- Online Public Hearing – Planning Board – July 23
- Planning Board work sessions – September and October (4 to 5 sessions anticipated)
- Transmittal of comments to County Council and the County Executive – November
- County Council Review/Approval – January-March 2021
- Final Montgomery County Complete Streets Design Guideline prepared
