Description

This will be a briefing on the transportation element of the attached Working Draft of the 2020-2024 County Growth Policy (Subdivision Staging Policy).

Background/Overview

The County Growth Policy, or Subdivision Staging Policy (SSP), is a set of policy tools that guide the timely delivery of public facilities (schools, transportation, water, sewer, and other infrastructure) to serve existing and future development. These policy tools are the guidelines for the administration of the county's Adequate Public Facility Ordinance.

This quadrennial update to the policy reflects an effort that has been data-driven and stakeholder informed. The Working Draft of the 2020 Subdivision Staging Policy contains new ideas that are intended to retrofit the current Local Area Transportation Review (LATR) process to better reflect Vision Zero principles. It also includes ideas that rethink how we approach the evaluation of transportation adequacy for master plans/sector plans.
