Dear Chairman Anderson,

The Friends of Ten Mile Creek and Little Seneca Reservoir support Montgomery Parks' recommended authorization of 18.54 acres at 15000 West Old Baltimore Road in Boyds, to add to Black Hill Regional Park. This land lies along Ten Mile Creek just downstream of the ford and is across from the 100-acre Ten Mile Creek Greenway that will link Black Hill Regional Park to the future Ten Mile Creek Conservation Park. Little Seneca Reservoir is not only a critical drinking-water resource but also a major regional recreational resource, so protection of its watershed should be a very high priority for the Planning Board.
