






Staff Recommendation:

The Planning Board will receive public testimony on the Great Seneca Science Corridor Minor Master Plan Amendment. Summary

Staff presented the Working Draft of the Great Seneca Science Corridor Minor Master Plan Amendment to the Planning Board on April 22, 2021. The Planning Board authorized staff to prepare the Public Hearing Draft of the Amendment and the Board scheduled a public hearing for June 3, 2021 to take place virtually. The public hearing was advertised in the Washington Times on May 3, 2021.

Staff requests that the public hearing record remain open until June 13, ten days after the June 3 hearing, for additional written testimony to be submitted to the Planning Board. Staff will summarize the testimony and conduct the first work session with the Planning Board on June 17, 2021.
