ACTION REQUESTED

Approve fees as proposed for M-NCPPC Montgomery Parks Facilities and Programs

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the Department's Policy on User Fees, the Enterprise Division, which manages ice rinks, tennis centers, event centers, and seasonal park amenity facilities and the Horticulture, Forestry, and Environmental Education (HFEE) Division which is responsible for the nature centers and community garden plots presents user fee recommendations to the Planning Board on an annual or as needed basis.

Prior to developing the proposed user fee schedules for facilities or programs, staff conducts surveys of other local jurisdictions' user fees for similar facilities. This information, together with input from department staff, attendance information and use patterns for each facility is used to draft the recommended schedule of fees.

Regular and timely fee adjustments are necessary to keep our fees competitive with comparable public and private self-supporting facilities or programs and/or to respond to market influences that affect pricing, user demand, etc.

The Enterprise Division's facilities are mandated by the County Council to be completely self-supporting, including facility operating costs, capital improvements and debt service for new facilities. The Parks Department's mission is to provide affordable and safe recreational programs and amenities for all. While our proposed fees reflect that mission, the County Council mandate has a significant impact on our ability to keep our fees affordable for all county residents. The Enterprise Division provides a 50% fee reduction for general admission fees, group lessons and programs for low-income residents. In addition, the Division uses advertised "Specials" or discounts to increase participation, thus increasing revenues. Staff continually monitors and assesses facility usage to increase participation.

Consistent with the Department's user fee policy, user fees for self-supporting Enterprise facilities, services, and programs are established at a level which (1) is competitive with comparable public and private facilities and services in the area; (2) can reasonably be expected to generate sufficient revenue to sustain administrative, operating and maintenance costs; (3) may generate surplus operating income to fund capital improvements at existing and developing facilities; and (4) reflects user demand and patterns of use.

For FY22 and FY23, the Enterprise Division's budget reflects a major increase in personnel costs. These costs include the impact of the seasonal/intermittent employee's minimum wage increase to \$15/hour, career vacancies being filled at higher rates due to a competitive job market and increased benefit costs. The Enterprise Division relies heavily on seasonal/intermittent employees to operate both seasonal and year-round facilities and programs. This critical staffing includes employees who work as front desk staff, rink guards, instructors, camp leaders, and who serve as the manager on duty when a career employee is not present or not available. The Commission recently announced that it will increase its minimum wage to \$15 per hour beginning January 1, 2022. M-NCPPC decided to implement the increase now, rather than follow the State of Maryland's recommended incremental approach to increase rates of pay over the next four years to meet the goal of \$15 per hour. Many of our current seasonal/intermittent employees are being paid less than the \$15 per hour rate. Therefore, this change will significantly impact the ability of the Enterprise Division to be self-supporting. For FY22, this minimum wage increase is projected to increase costs by about \$120k. In FY23, the overall increase in personnel costs from the FY22 adopted budget will impact the Enterprise budget by \$365k.

The FY22 and FY23 fee increases include rates for the Ice Rinks, Miniature Trains and Carousel, Little Bennett Campground, South Germantown Driving Range and Splashpark, Brookside Gardens, Permits, and Nature Centers. The additional revenue will be used to cover the increased FY22 and FY23 personnel costs and other operational expenses. There will be continual monitoring and review of revenues and expenditures to maintain a net profit for the Enterprise Division and Special Revenue Funds.

Because of this known increased cost to the divisions, as well as the conclusions drawn from our review of current fees, the request to increase fees is as follows:
