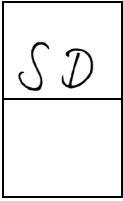
Description

Summary

- Reappoint three members of the Bethesda Downtown Sector Plan Implementation Advisory Committee (IAC) to three-year terms.

SECTION 1: BACKGROUND

As outlined in the *Approved and Adopted Bethesda Downtown Sector Plan*, in 2017 the Planning Department created a representative and balanced Implementation Advisory Committee (IAC) to coordinate and monitor the progress of development and address implementation of the recommendations in the *Approved and Adopted Bethesda Downtown Sector Plan*.

The IAC is made up of up to seven representatives each from the business community and residents of downtown Bethesda. The Planning Board appoints members to serve three-year terms. Members are eligible for reappointment upon completion of their terms and may self-nominate. Members may serve two full consecutive terms.

The Planning Board appointed the initial 14-member IAC in December 2017.

SECTION 2: CANDIDATES

Three current IAC members, whose first three-year terms have expired, have indicated their interest in reappointment (attached). Staff nominates for second and final three-year terms Joyce Gwadz, Edgemoor resident, and Dedun Ingram, Town of Chevy Chase resident, to resident seats, and Christopher Smith, Development Manager with Stonebridge, to a business seat.
