

SUMMARY

- The 2023 Bethesda Downtown Plan Annual Monitoring Report (AMR) provides an update on the implementation of the *Bethesda Downtown Sector Plan* since last year's report was issued.

SUMMARY

The *Bethesda Downtown Sector Plan* comprises numerous interrelated and interdependent recommendations which depend upon coordination among many agencies and private developers. The Sector Plan recommends annual monitoring of development activity, schools, parks, and transportation.

This report provides a detail review of the Plan's implementation over the past year since the last report was issued in July of 2022, including development approvals, Bethesda Overlay Zone (BOZ) density, schools, existing and recommended parks and open space, transportation and a new section that provides updates on tree canopy and green cover.
