Section 50.6.3.B

Summary

- Section 50.6.3.B of the Subdivision Regulations generally states that an Administrative Subdivision Plan must be acted upon by the Planning Director or scheduled for a public hearing within 90 days after the date of acceptance. For this application, the last Planning Board date within the 90-day period is November 30, 2022. The Planning Board may, however, extend this period.
- The Development Review Committee (DRC) meeting for this application was held on September 26, 2023
- The Applicant is requesting an additional four (4) month extension of the review period to March 28, 2023.
- This extension will allow the Applicant time to Address DRC comments and resolve community concerns relating to tree preservation issues.
