Summary

- Section 50.4.1.E provides a 120-day review period for Preliminary Plan hearings. The Planning Board may, however, extend this period.
- The Application was accepted on March 12, 2025, which established a Planning Board date no later than July 10, 2025. The Applicant was granted a 30-day extension by the Planning Director, establishing a Planning Board date not later than August 12, 2025. The Applicant was granted a second extension for 2-months by the Planning Board, establishing a Planning Board date not later than October 12, 2025.
- The Applicant was most recently granted a third extension for 3-months by the Planning Board, establishing a new Planning Board date not later than January 12, 2026.
- The Applicant is requesting an additional 2-month extension of the review period to March 12, 2026.
- The Applicant has retained land use counsel and proposed a modified approach for the Preliminary Plan Amendment. The Applicant and Staff recently met and coordinated on the Amendment. With the upcoming holidays, additional time is needed to finalize the application for a Planning Board hearing.
- The Planning Board hearing on the application may take place before the end of the review period and will be publicly noticed in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance.
- Staff recommends APPROVAL of the extension request.

On behalf of BRL Holdings LLC ("Ben Lewis"), I hereby submit this fourth regulatory extension request to continue the January 8, 2026, Planning Board public hearing for approximately 60 days or until March 12, 2026 the last Thursday within said 60-day period.¹

A 60-day regulatory extension is being requested out of an abundance of caution. The Applicant retained the undersigned counsel in conjunction with the third regulatory request. Subsequently, the Applicant, through counsel, proposed a slightly modified Preliminary Plan Amendment. The Applicant and Staff have just recently coordinated on the updated Preliminary Plan Amendment. In light thereof and the upcoming holidays, additional time is needed to finalize this application for the Planning Board public hearing. Although it is not anticipated that the full 60 days will be needed, the Applicant would rather request more time than is needed, than have this Board unnecessarily review another regulatory extension request.
